

# **NHSBFAA Executive Board Meeting Minutes**

September 11, 2017 Carolina Brewery – 7:30pm

#### Present:

- I. Charger Card Distribution Plan
  - a. Waiting until tomorrow to get Charger Cards to groups who haven't picked up cards then other groups can request more.
- II. Minutes of Previous Meeting
  - a. The 8/21/17 General Meeting minutes were approved by the Executive Board at the 8/30/2017 meeting called by Rick Thompson.

## III. Reports

- a. Treasurer's monthly report
  - i. Deposits on Tuesday and Friday of each week
    - 1. Carole said she is still getting emails requesting checks and not getting check requests in writing on the proper form. Ken suggested enforcing the correct process to coaches/groups who aren't following proper protocol so they can get in the habit of doing things right.
    - 2. Ken brought to Carole's attention that there have been checks written in the past with 2 different sequence numbers. Carole said this is because prior board members had 2 separate check books. Carole is going to stop and order a new book of checks to start fresh.
  - ii. Check requests: fulfilled on Tuesday and Friday of each week.
    - 1. Carole is getting emails on various days.
    - 2. Rick will go over the deposit & check request process at the next Coaches meeting. Rick stated we need a check request form.
  - iii. Financial reports update itemized sport reports
    - 1. Ken is still working with Quickbooks to try and get reports run. Things are coming along OK. The goal is to have a template for sport financial reports by end of September 2017.
- b. President's report
  - i. Financial reports will be available each month on the 1st and 15th.
    - 1. Still working with Quickbooks to get reports to generate

#### ii. Coaches Compensation Plan

- 1. Rick got approval to work on a plan. Will need to provide coaches with 1099 and they will be paid as contractors/self-employment. Coaches are paid out of the particular sport's funds available. [Addendum to minutes added by President: --or separate retention and coaches fund to be set up in Nov or Dec of 2017]
- iii. Rosters of teams, posters, schedule cards, etc.
  - 1. Rick talked about selling advertisements to print rosters for games. He is working on a solution for ad sales.

### c. Agenda items:

i. Website discussion - Rick said this is ongoing.

#### d. Fundraising:

- i. Fundraisers for teams (lacrosse website and gear)
  - 1. Lacrosse sent in a recommendation to do fundraising for customized gear similar to BSN options. [Addendum to minutes added by President: --and team apparel outside of current BSN agreement. Rick is checking on options.]
- ii. Coaches Compensation plan (duplicate item please see III. b. ii.)
- iii. Major project update
  - 1. People have made inquiries about facilities improvements. Rick reported that the county office said if we raise the money and get it approved, then we can move forward with projects.
- iv. Fundraising departments
  - 1. Will need people to run/facilitate fundraising departments. Will only be successful with help outside of the BFAA Board. [Addendum to minutes added by President: -- Committees include: Charger Cards, Memberships, Concessions, Facility Improvements, Corporate Sponsorships & Ad Sales]

#### IV. General Business – concession funds

- a. How Fall, Winter, Spring sports are paid for concessions
  - i. Rick found most recent Concessions policy dated August 1, 2015 (also on BFAA website)
- b. Concession stand ordering Popcorn popper, ECC Integration
  - i. Funds for popcorn popper in Football/Soccer/Lacrosse concession stand will come out of General Funds.
  - ii. Frances suggested talking to someone in Softball about borrowing theirs until the new one is delivered.
  - iii. CTE groups want to work ECC games to make money.
    - 1. Concerns: training, making sure enough parents are there to work the stand, restocking and inventory
    - 2. Question: Is ECC trying to split the profit?
    - 3. We have to wait until ECC submits a proposal before we can make a decision on this

- c. Other Concession reports:
  - i. Question: Will cheese and chili machines in Football be used for other sports? Yes, was paid for out of General Funds.
  - ii. We have to be more diligent about food/inventory only being used within the same season between the sports who split the bill of expenses. Example: Food purchased by a fall sport (football) cannot be used by a winter sport (basketball). Transfer of foods will go through Regina.
