Rick opened the meeting.

Meeting opened with discussion on the magnets Rick ordered. An email thread went around a few weeks ago that talked about this as a good fundraiser- we will make \$4.40 on each one sold.

A new fundraising committee will be forming soon. Ivey Arnold was introduced as the new social media fundraising POC.

Next topic of discussion took place about how to get new members, how much it should cost, benefits to the parent, etc. Some recommendations were put forth. The group suggested we ask each parent with a kid in a sport to join Boosters for \$X. For joining they would also receive a decal. Also, businesses would get a storefront decal if they supported us for \$X. Some discussion ensued concerning how much the parent membership could cost, what value would be given to the parent. First, \$20 was mentioned; some were afraid this was too high. So \$10 was discussed. There was also talk of coupling the membership with a magnet- both for \$12/\$14. Rick mentioned that the most important things to take care of affect all sports- trainer and weight room. We would like to see the trainer roll expanded to add another person. The weight room could use some upgrades as well.

Conversation turned to check on each sub-group. Concessions is doing fine according to Charity. There is some concern that money will be lost on the rainout from last Friday, but there are still enough home games that we should be able to make up the loss.

Discussion then came up about the need to sell rosters/programs for both football and basketball. Expanding this thought- we could sell sponsorships to local businesses for a place in the booklet. The last fundraiser that was brought up was the Golf Tournament that has been mentioned before. We need more volunteers in order to make this happen.

Finance: Johnny said that everything was balanced. There may be a few items that need to be reclassified, but everything looked good. Carole mentioned the HOSA trip is finally paid for per last May (2017) request. The total was \$1,100 as we were finally invoiced from the County. Clarity on this was a 'one-time' request and the trip already occurred. The boost club just had not receive an invoice.
